April 15, 2018 3rd Sunday of Easter

Imagine being one of the disciples in today's Gospel. You have just heard of Jesus' appearance on the road to Emmaus, which, along with the amazing story of the tomb, has given you a surge of hope. However, the grief and fear you felt during the crucifixion still remain in your heart. You want to believe that he has risen as he said, but a pall of paralyzing uncertainty hangs over everything.

Suddenly, he's in the room, standing right in front of you. Of course, he knows what you are feeling. "Why are you frightened, and why do doubts arise in your hearts?" He asks. "Touch me and see." You do see.

Appearing before the disciples, Jesus gave them precisely what they needed for the next phase of their mission. He reassured and strengthened them by replacing their fear and uncertainty with peace and joy. He made the scriptures intelligible to them so that they'd be able to pass on his wisdom.

Why do fear and doubt arise in our hearts when Jesus calls us to something new? His death was the ultimate proof that his love for us knows no bounds. Just as he prepared the disciples for their mission, so he will prepare us for ours.

Here is another excerpt from Sherry Weddell's book, <u>Forming Intentional Disciples</u> which our Parish Pastoral Council has been exploring.



Father Ed Fride has pastored Christ the King Parish (in Ann Arbor, Michigan) for nineteen years. He says, Discipleship is absolutely central to the parish......The spirituality of the parish, in which a personal relationship with Jesus is continually stressed, is key.....We began as, and still are, part of the charismatic renewal, again where a living, active relationship with Jesus is encouraged......The core thing is that it always has to come back to the Eucharist. Invite people to live with Him, and for Him, anchor people in the Eucharist, and they won't wander off. This is just one reason our Parish Mission Statement has combined the invitation to discipleship along with the need to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. Just as Jesus Christ gathered his disciples around the Table of the Eucharist, we too, must see ourselves as his disciples who are fed by the Living Eucharist and being sent out into the world to teach and live the Good News.

Father Ed joked, This parish is a cry room with a tabernacle attached. He made it clear that making disciples of the children is a major priority......We want our children to know God, that He is real, He wants to be their friend. By the time they receive First Communion, they are literally vibrating at the touch of the Holy Spirit; they are so excited that they can hardly stand still. Indeed, discipleship begins when we are first introduced to Jesus in the Sacrament of Holy Communion. Each time they come to the Eucharist, each time we come to the Eucharist, we are drawn deeper into our relationship with Jesus and recognize the importance of being his disciples who are sent to announce the Good News.
