**Trinity Sunday**

---

Trinity Sunday is a day to reflect upon and celebrate just who our God is. God is revealed to us first and foremost as a saving God. That is what today's first reading celebrates. The Jewish people knew their God's identity because of his saving acts.

Christian belief in the Trinity was not the result of philosophical reflection on the nature of God. Rather, it developed as Christians reflected on their experience of salvation in Jesus Christ and the presence of his spirit – the spirit crying out to God, revealed by Christ as “Abba, Father” – within their very souls.

Jesus and the Holy Spirit were experienced as doing what only God can do – saving us – and so they must be divine. But good Jews knew that God is one. This is the origin of the doctrine of the Trinity.

Only later did philosophical precision give us language like “three persons,” “one nature,” “hypostatic union,” etc. These are important to keep Christian faith from being misunderstood, but they are not the core of our faith in the Trinity. The core is that the same God who saved the Jewish people from slavery in Egypt has also saved us from slavery to sin through his Son Jesus Christ, and that we can experience that salvation even today, even at this Mass, through the ministry of their Holy Spirit.


**FAITH FORMATION FOR PARENTS!**
